UNIFORM SHOP

School uniforms are available from St Joseph's School from our Uniform Shop,
Opening Times: Tuesday & Thursday – 8.00 till 9.00 am

The school shop is managed by a paid convenor with assistance from parent volunteers. It enables parents to purchase **school uniforms and textbook and stationary requirements**. Payment can be made via cash, cheque, credit card or EFTPOS facility located within the shop.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

School Uniform requirements are clearly set out and staff members are asked to monitor compliance with the requirements. Students are to be dressed in full school uniforms at all times.

If it is not sold in the uniform shop, it is not to be worn.

Wearing of hats is particularly important – if a child has no hat, he/she remains in the shade/sheltered area in the playground.

Dress uniforms are worn three days per week and the Sports Uniforms on two. The actual days are determined each year.

REGULATIONS

Wearing the correct full school uniform is a condition of enrolment. Parents should explain any deviation from this in writing to the Principal.

Dress and grooming should be of a high standard.

Black leather shoes/ black leather joggers with school socks should be worn each day with the school uniform.

No jewellery is to be worn apart from the following:- a watch, a single plain sleepers/studs (with safety catches) **in each ear**. This includes "coloured clothes day".

Hairstyles should be appropriate. Students with long hair over shoulder length must have it tied back completely with the appropriate coloured ribbons or "scrunches" (white, orange or blue).

No hat, no outdoor play! All children are expected to wear their school hats any time they are outdoors.

Navy blue micro-fibre shorts should be worn only on the days required.

Fingernails should be cut short and kept clean and unpolished. (No fingernail polish).

WHAT IS INAPPROPRIATE?

- Noticeably dyed or coloured hair
- Long or un-kept hair
- 'tracks' or other designs cut into hair
- the wearing of earrings or studs for boys
- Body piercing or tattoos
- Other clothing visible under uniforms i.e. boxer shorts, board shorts.
