Prep Levy

In addition to the fees and levies quoted previously in this Schedule, there is a **\$182 levy per child**. The levy is in lieu of a booklist.

Technology Levy – Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6

In addition to the fees and levies quoted previously in this Schedule, there is an annual levy for students in Year 4, 5 & 6.

Yr6 Diary

Students in Yr 6 are required to purchase a St Joseph's Diary – the cost is \$10.50.

Camps

Students in years 4 to 6 attend a camp or day retreat each year – **the cost for the camp or day retreat is in addition to fees.**

Band

Participation in the program is \$580 p.a. for both Senior and Junior Bands.

CONCESSIONS

Families experiencing financial hardship may apply for a concession on school fees. All concessions are reviewed annually and involve completing a Concession Application Form, providing proof of income etc. and attending an interview with the Finance Secretary or Principal. All genuine cases of financial hardship will be considered; however, it is our hope that all families will make a concerted effort to meet their financial obligations.

OTHER EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Additional extracurricular activities, such as piano and tennis lessons, can be arranged by families direct with tutors who provide lessons on site. Payments for these activities are to be made directly to the relevant tutors and are not included in the school's fee schedule.
